Review of EESAC Bylaws

The purpose of the J.C. Bermudez Senior High School Educational Excellence Advisory Council is to work together to ensure improved student achievement. One of the ways the EESAC will do this is by preparing and evaluating the School Improvement Plan.

The EESAC shall be made up of 5 teachers, 5 parents, 2 students, 1 education support employee, 3 business/community representatives, the UTD steward, and the principal.

Council members are expected to:

- 1. attend all regular and special meetings.
- 2. communicate with constituents to collect data and opinions for decision making.
- 3. report to constituents the actions taken by the Council, and
- 4. consider the needs of all students when making decisions.

Review of EESAC Bylaws (cont.)

EESAC meetings will take place at least **once every nine weeks** unless circumstances should arise that require additional meetings. *All meetings will be conducted virtually at 6:00 p.m.*

In the event a special meeting is needed, the principal, chairperson or a majority of the Council members may call a meeting.

All meetings shall be open to the public and shall not be held in any facility or location, which discriminates based on sex, age, race, color, creed, origin, or economic status or which operates in such manner as to restrict access unreasonably to such a facility.

- Teachers will meet monthly to translate the academic vision of our school into strategic objectives and measures of progress and targets.
- The Leadership Team monthly meetings will be held with various stakeholders to help problem solve, discuss and build capacity to improve school wide concerns.
- The administrative team will engage in data chats monthly with individual teachers to review student achievement and track their academic progress.

SIP Action Planning (cont.)

- Leadership team will continually gather monthly information on student achievement and communicate it to the school's community as part of the plan's monitoring and evaluation process.
- Teachers will initiate individual and small group programs monthly to provide additional intervention and enrichment learning time for students.
- Teachers will set monthly clear targets for academic school year and gauge and report on progress via performance measures that relate to school/building level autonomy as well as the district.
