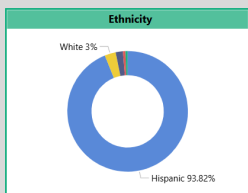

Conduct and Effort Grades

Conduct Grades

Conduct grades are used to communicate a student's behavior and citizenship development. These grades are independent of academic and effort grades.

Effort Grades

Effort grades reflect the student's potential, study habits, and attitude.

- 1: Outstanding Effort
- 2: Satisfactory Effort
- 3: Insufficient Effort

Ranking

Rank is reported using a weighted system. Miami-Dade County Public Schools does not utilize numerical ranking.

Grade Scale

J.C. Bermudez Doral Senior High School follows the grading policies established by Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS), including the bonus point system used to weight advanced-level course grades. The standard grading scale is based on a 4.0 system:

- **A: 90 – 100 or 3.5 – 4.0**

- Grade Points: 4
- Bonus Points:
 - Honors: 1
 - Advanced Placement, AICE, and Dual Enrollment: 2
 - Verbal Interpretation: Outstanding progress

- **B: 80 – 89 or 2.5 – 3.4**

- Grade Points: 3
- Bonus Points:
 - Honors: 1
 - Advanced Placement, AICE, and Dual Enrollment: 2
 - Verbal Interpretation: Good progress

- **C: 70 – 79 or 1.5 – 2.4**

- Grade Points: 2
- Bonus Points:
 - Honors: 1
 - Advanced Placement, AICE, and Dual Enrollment: 1
 - Verbal Interpretation: Average progress

- **D: 60 – 69 or 1.0 – 1.4**

- Grade Points: 1
- Bonus Points:
 - Honors: 0
 - Advanced Placement, AICE, and Dual Enrollment: 0
 - Verbal Interpretation: Lowest acceptable progress

- **F: 0 – 59 or 0 – 0.9**

- Grade Points: 0
- Bonus Points:
 - Honors: 0
 - Advanced Placement, AICE, and Dual Enrollment: 0
 - Verbal Interpretation: Failure

Note: Students who earn more than the required number of credits are not penalized in their rank in class.
