ATTENDANCE PROCEDURES

Procedures for Parents to Submit an Excused Admit/Note to School

Absences shall be reported to the student's enrolled school by the parent/legal guardian no later than three (3) days from the date of the absence.

ATTENDANCE PROCEDURES

Parents will have three ways to submit an admit:

The email must include the following:

- Date of Absence
- Reason for the Absence

ATTENDANCE PROCEDURES

- 2. <u>VIA THE PARENT PORTAL OR MOBILE APP</u>: A link will be available via the Parent Portal and MDCPS Mobile App for parents to submit admits directly to the school. Through the app, parents will be able to submit attachments and documentation.
- 3. <u>IN-PERSON</u>: Parents who wish to submit documentation in person, may do so at the school's attendance office.

Failure to report and explain the absence(s) shall result in unexcused absence(s). The principal shall have the final authority for determining acceptability of the reason for the absence(s).

Every effort needs to be made by the student, parent, and school administration to avoid absences related to technical difficulties, such as the lack of reliable connectivity or device accessibility.

UNIFORM DRESS CODE

Our School Uniform Policy is mandatory and is as follows:

- POLOS Royal Blue, White or Gray. Polos must always be tucked in.
- <u>BOTTOMS</u> Khaki Beige, Dark Blue or Black pants must be worn at the waist with a belt and fit loosely. The following styles/fits are NOT allowed: skinny, athletic, joggers, leggings, jeggings, jeans, colored denim, nylon, cargo, knitted, or corduroy.
- OUTERWEAR Thunder Sweatshirts may be worn every day but must be worn over polos (M-TH) and over spirit t-shirts on Fridays. Other sweatshirts, sweaters and jackets must NOT have hoodies. Outerwear is required to be solid colors; royal blue, white or gray (black is allowed) and must be worn with a uniform polo underneath.
- SHOES Only closed-toe shoes are allowed.
- <u>FRIDAYS</u> Students may wear a school approved academy/club/athletic top and the Thunder Spirit T-Shirt with uniform bottoms.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Standard Diploma Requirements

Academic Advisement - What Students and Parents Need to Know

What are the diploma options?

Students must successfully complete one of the following diploma options:

- 24-credit standard diploma
- 18-credit Academically Challenging Curriculum to Enhance Learning (ACCEL)
- Career and Technical Education (CTE) Pathway
- Advanced International Certificate of Education (AICE) curriculum
- International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma curriculum

What are the state assessment requirements?

Students must pass the following statewide assessments:

- Grade 10 English Language Arts (ELA) or a concordant score
- Algebra 1 end of course (EOC) or a comparative

Refer to Graduation Requirements for Florida's Statewide Assessments for concordant and comparative scores.

Students enrolled in the following courses must participate in the corresponding EOC assessment, which constitutes 30 percent of the final course grade+:

- Algebra 1
 Geometry
- Biology 1
 U.S. History

What is the difference between the 18-credit ACCEL option and the 24-credit option?

- 3 elective credits instead of 8
- Physical Education is not required
- · Online course is not required

What is the difference between the CTE Pathway option and the 24-credit option?

- At least 18 credits are required
- · 4 elective credits instead of 8
- o 2 credits in CTE courses, must result in completion and industry certification
- 2 credits in work-based learning programs or up to 2 elective credits including financial literacy
- Physical Education is not required
- Fine and Performing Arts, Speech and Debate, or Practical Arts is not required
- · Online course is not required

24 Credit Standard Diploma

4 Credits ELA

- ELA 1, 2, 3, 4
- ELA honors, Advanced Placement (AP), AICE, IB and dual enrollment courses may satisfy this requirement

4 Credits Mathematics*

- One of which must be Algebra 1 and one of which must be Geometry
- Industry Certifications that lead to college credit may substitute for up to two mathematics credits (except for Algebra 1 and Geometry)
- An identified computer science** credit may substitute for up to one mathematics credit (except for Algebra 1 and Geometry)

3 Credits Science

- One of which must be Biology 1, two of which must be equally rigorous science courses
- Two of the three required course credits must have a laboratory component
- Industry Certifications that lead to college credit may substitute for up to one science credit (except for
- An identified computer science** credit may substitute for up to one science credit (except for Biology 1)

3 Credits Social Studies

- 1 credit in World History
- 1 credit in U.S. History
- 0.5 credit in U.S. Government
- 0.5 credit in Economics

Students must earn a 2.0 grade point average (GPA) on a 4.0 scale for all cohort years and pass statewide, standardized assessments unless a waiver of assessment results is granted by the IEP team for students with






